Individual Recreational Poomsae

- All belt levels, all ages
- Divisions of 4-8 people lined up at event
- Double elimination format
 - O Competitor performs one poomsae according to their belt level the one they learned for the belt they are wearing or the pattern they are learning for their next belt level
 - o White belt competitors may perform the 10 move pattern or their 'basic' pattern
 - o Player must lose 2 times to be eliminated
- Uniform is any style white Taekwondo dobok, appropriate belt, bare feet

Team Poomsae (formerly 'Family' patterns)

- Teams may consist of any combination of belt level and ages
- Perform the highest poomsae common to all members of the team
- Divisions will be based on levels, ages, and pattern performed
- CREATIVE DIVISION will be formed for non-recognized poomsae
- Team members MUST indicate on their registration form that they will be performing team patterns

Black Belt Sport Poomsae

- World Taekwondo poomsae rules (September 30, 2024)
- NOTE: Youth divisions are not official but will follow the same rules as official Cadet divisions
- Uniform Sport Poomsae uniform <u>recommended</u> but NOT MANDATORY



- Master categories are U60 and older
- <u>Individual</u> competitors will perform poomsae side by side poomsae draws will be conducted before each match
- <u>Pairs and teams</u> will use the cut-off system of competition; poomsae draws will be conducted at the beginning of pairs and teams divisions

Individual Recreational Sparring

- All ages and belt levels
- Head contact rules
 - NO head contact in colour belt divisions
 - NO head contact in youth divisions
 - Head contact optional in black belt cadet and older divisions
- Equipment: Head and chest protector, groin guard (male and female), mouth guard, shin and arm pads
 - NOTE: All braces MUST be covered by a mouth guard
- Uniform: Any style white Taekwondo dobok and appropriate belt
- Format
 - Sparring will consist of a combination of sparfest-style matches and scored matches
 - o Scored matches will feature the brand new WT approved Waychamp scoring equipment
 - Competitors will begin their sparring by completing at least 2 sparfest-style matches timed, one-round, no score fights
 - Center referee will control the sparfest-style match
 - Center referee will guide the students and let them know when they're breaking rules but not impose gam-jeoms
 - Coaches are welcome to coach before and after the match and from the sidelines during the match
 - Once competitors have completed 2 sparfest-style matches they may proceed to a best-of-three, scored match, where they will fight for silver or gold
 - o If they choose not to continue to a best-of-three, scored match, they may claim a bronze medal for their sparfest-style matches
- Competitors will be organized into pools based on registrations and matched with opponents on the day of the event

ATTENTION FIRST TIME SPARRING COMPETITORS - ANY BELT LEVEL

- First time competitors may indicate in their registration that this is their first tournament sparring experience
- Organizers will try their best to ensure that less experienced competitors are matched with one another

Tag Team Sparring

- Participants will be organized into teams or 3 or more members and divisions based on registrations
- Teams may be mixed gender, all male, or all female and can include any belt levels
- Competitors may either specify their team preference or be assigned to a team by organizers
- Matches will be safely and fairly controlled by the center referee
- Matches will be scored by 3 corner judges during three 3-minute rounds of play
- Gam-leoms will be imposed according to current WT sparring rules
- Absolutely NO head contact is allowed in team sparring
- Further details and rules will be announced on competition day

Little Ninjas Competition

- Suitable for very young competitors with little or no competition experience
- Parents should use their discretion to determine if Little Ninjas competition is suitable for their child

 - o Encourages evasion techniques without kicking or punching
 - Equipment will be provided
- Warrior Path
 - Obstacle course races
 - Fun and challenging agility and speed competition
- Candy Cane Smash
 - Board breaking
 - o Hammer fist technique
